Ileana Rodríguez is Humanities Distinguished Professor of Spanish at the Ohio State University. Her areas of research include post-colonial theory, feminist and subaltern studies, with a focus on cultural production from Central America and the Caribbean. She is the author of several books, including: *Gender Violence in Failed and Democratic States* (Pallgrave, 2016), *Liberlistm at its Limits: Crime and Terror in the Latin American Cultural Text* (U of Pittsburgh P., 2009), and *Women Guerrillas, and Love: Understanding War in Central America* (U of Minnesota P, 1996) .
